in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Fifty (\$850.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by T. L. Bramlette

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said T. L. Bramlette, the following described real estate to wit: All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on the White Oak Church Road about three and one half miles from the City of Greenville, adjoining the lands of the said W. R. Hudson and John G. Gorman being a part of the tract of land purchased by John Gorman from W. H. A. A. Co. and having the following boundaries: Beginning at Stone G. F. B. corner, and running thence S. 4 7/8 E. 72.6 feet to iron pin; thence S. 84 1/2 E. 27.1 feet 9 inches to iron pin; thence N. 33 E. 22.5 feet to stone; thence N. 87 1/4 E. 58.8 feet 4 inches to the beginning corner, containing five and one half acres more or less. A strip of land on the West side of this lot, 12 feet wide adjoining J. F. Brown's land and running full length of 72.6 feet, and out into the White Oak Road is hereby specifically excepted from the land herein conveyed; the said strip of land having been reserved in the deed from John Gorman to me;

in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other considerations in the State aforesaid to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. D. Westervelt,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. D. Westervelt, all those two certain lots of land on the West side of Mooney Road, County and State aforesaid, known and designated as lots # 6 and # 13, as shown on plat of subdivision of lots of W. D. Parrish made by R. E.
