to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by H. D. Howard, of the County and  
State aforesaid  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto  
the said H. D. Howard and his heirs and assigns, all that  
certain piece or tract of land, situate, lying and  
being in the State of South Carolina and County of  
Greenville, in Glassy Mountain Township, one mile  
of South Pacquet and Margaret Creek road, having  
the following lines and bounds to wit:  
Beginning at a chestnut 3 1/4, and running  
thence nearly West to a sycamore tree 3 1/4, thence  
nearly West to a steeple at the Spring, at Joshua  
Lindsey's line, thence nearly East with Joshua  
Lindsey's line to a Hickory 3 1/4; thence nearly  
South East course to a Pine 3 1/4, and East part of
