for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty-four and 29/100 DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
W.P. Thompson, in the State aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto
the said W.P. Thompson, All that piece, parcel or tract of land containing two and one-fourth
acres, more or less, situated on waters of Stillhouse Branch. Being part of land bot of
Mrs. M.L.G. Ridgeway in Fall 1916, known as a part of the 14 acre tract, originally surveyed
by D.H. Boyce.

The 2-1/4 acres, being surveyed to-day by W.M. Nash, Surveyor: Beginning at stone old on hill
thence N. 1/2 W. 8.21 to stone by Pasture; thence N. 79-1/2 E. 2.45 to iron stake on East

the said W.A. Chandler, the following described real-estate, to-wit:

" All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated, lying and being in the State and
County aforesaid, on the White Oak Church Road, about three and one-half miles from the City
of Greenville; adjoining the lends of W.R. Hudson and John Garraux, being a part of the tract of
land purchased by John Garraux from W.H. Austin, Jr. and having the following metes and bounds:
