House and Public road and to construct and maintain in and upon said premises in a proper manner with poles, towers, wires, and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right, at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other like obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same said line to remain as now located along and adjoining said public road, this deed to be void if said line be not constructed and put in operation within a reasonable time from this date.
