(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
E.E. Reeves, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on Pendleton Street extension, beyond the incorpo-
rate limits of the City of Greenville, being lot number two (2) of Block D., of the Melville
Subdivision, as shown by plat thereof recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in plat
Book A., at page 97, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:
Beginning on Pendleton Street extension at corner of lot No. 1, a distance of 53.60 feet from
corner of Pendleton and Aiken Streets, and running thence S. 43-45 W. 147.1 feet to corner of
