(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Avery Center, all that certain piece parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid and in the Township of Glassy Mountain and having the following metes and bounds: beginning at a rock near old grave yard on line of Jas. A.
