Joseph Wooten, a lot or parcel of ground in Maceland Cemetery Greenville County, South Carolina, designated as Lot No. 86 Section No. 20 containing 200 square feet, more or less, the same being described as above in accordance with map on file in the office of Maceland Cemetery. It is distinctly understood that said lot is to be used exclusively for the burial of human bodies of the white race and is sold and conveyed subject to all rules and amendments for the government of the cemetery which may hereafter be adopted

AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Joseph Wooten, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
