Jenkinson (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J.R. Jenkinson, his heirs and assigns, all that piece parcel or lot of land in the City and County of Greenville in said State on the South side of Washington Street with lines as follows: Beginning on corner of lots three and four of the land platted for W. I. Shumate and on Washington Street running thence along the line between these two lots S. 42° 30' N. Seventy five feet to a corner, thence on a line of the lot I have conveyed to W. D. Workman S. 47° 44' E. twenty five feet to a corner in a line with the outside of the West side of the wall of the brick wall on W. D.
