 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

William Holdsmith, his heirs and assigns: All those two certain lots or parcels of land, lying and being situate on the north side of Augusta Road, just outside of the City of Greenville County, and State aforesaid, and being known and designated on a plat of Crescent Terrace, as lots Nos. 55 and 56, said plat being recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "E" at page 137, and reference thereto will show the said lots to be described as follows:
