(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
 A. E. Payne, his heirs and assigns, all that certain
 piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying
 and being in the County and State aforesaid,
 on branches of Armstrong Creek and to the
 wet land of said Armstrong Creek, Branch
 Waters of Saluda River, Beginning at rock 3,840 m
 Embank'd corner on said Embank'd Spring Branch
 thence S. 40 E. 31.10 chs. to rock, 3,434 m: said Embank'd corner on shoal Branch; thence down said
 shoal branch 40 chs. to poplars, 3,40 m: (gone) at
 the wet land on Armstrong Creek; thence along
 the edge of the wet land on Armstrong Creek
