(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. J. Brown, his Heirs and Assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Bates Township, County and State aforesaid containing fifty-two and one half (52 1/2) acres more or less, and bounded by lands of W. A. Nesbitt, John Bolling, Mack Miller and Jas. Edwards, and being more fully described in a mortgage executed by David S. Springfield in favor of J. H. Springfield, and recorded in the office of the S. P. M. C. Office for said County and State in Book 35 at page 77. This being the same tract of land conveyed to me by E. L. Gannett Trustee of Greenville County on the 16th day of November 1917, and Deed recorded in the office of the S. P. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 521 at page 196. It is agreed and understood that the (Grantor) J. J. Brown herein is to assume the payment of all note and mortgage of Fourteen hundred Dollars, together with the interest thereon from date, executed to J. H. Smith by the (Grantor) herein (Mary Springfield) on Nov. 9th, 1917 and recorded in the office of the S. P. M. C. for Greenville Co. in Vol. 61 at page 228. The interest on the said note and mortgage for one year of Ninety-eight (\$98.00) Dollars having been paid by the (Grantor) to the said J. H. Smith. This note and mortgage of \$1400 is to be paid first payment of the said purchase price above mentioned. It is further agreed that the (Grantor) will convey eight cords of wood now cut on the above described property and retain the right to have said wood removed from the property.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. J. Brown, his heirs and assigns, forever.
