KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That f. S. Supo

in the State aforesaid,
in the County of Aiken in consideration of the sum of
Twenty-five Hundred (\$2500.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by B. S. Supo and W. A. Supo, composing
the firm of Supo Brothers, in the State
aforesaid, County of Greenville.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Supo Brothers, all that piece, parcel or tract
of land situate, lying and being in the
County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on
a new road from Monaghan Mills to the
White Horse Road and being situate a few
hundred yards South east of the Cunningham
Brothers stake, and containing ten and
eight tenths acres more or less and having
the following notes and bounds: Beginning
at a stake on the said road and running
along the same S. 26-15 E. 10.50 to a stake corner
thence S. 57-05 W. 9.18 to a stake, on corner lands
now or formerly Berry's, thence N. 40-30 W. 10.50 to
a stake corner lands now or formerly Cun-
ningham's thence N. 57 E. 11.58 to the beginning
corner on said road, and is the same tract
of land conveyed to me by B. S. Bridwell on Aug
12th 1916 and recorded in A. M. C. office for said
County in Volume 41 page 13.
And it is hereby agreed that the said Supo
Brothers are to assume the payment of a
mortgage given by B. S. Bridwell Dec 30th
1915 to secure the payment of fifteen hundred

Supo in his purchase, the said payment
being a part of the consideration of this
deed.
