 in consideration of the sum of
 Seventeen Hundred + ²⁴/₁₀₀ DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by J. I. West

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. I. West all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina County of Greenville, known and designated as a portion of lot No. Seven on plat dated February 26th, 1915, and recorded in the office of the Register of Meuse Conveyances for said County and State in plat Book "C" at page 223, and having according to said plat, the following meter and bounds to-wit: Beginning at a Stake on West side of Memminger Street Sixty-five (65) feet Southward from the South West corner of Memminger Street and Arlington Avenue (formerly known as Harlington Street) and running thence along said Memminger Street S. 16° 15' W. Sixty (60) feet to a stake in the corner of lot No. Eight (8) thence along line of last mentioned lot N. 73° 45' W. one Hundred and fifty Seven (157) feet to a stake on line of lot No. (5) five; thence along line of last mentioned lot N. 16° 15' E. Sixty feet (60) to a stake; thence S. 73° 45' E. one hundred and fifty-seven feet (157) to the beginning corner; this being the lot of land deeded to me by H. J. Mills on April 8th 1916 and said Deed is recorded in Book Vol. "34" page "219" in office of Register of Meuse Conveyances in Greenville Co. and reference to said Deed will fully show.
