KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. W. Hardin

DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Greenville-Carolina Trust Company

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Greenville-Carolina Trust Company, All that piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina, in Cleveland Township, about twenty five miles from Greenville on the Caesar Creek Road on Ball Rock Creek waters of the South Branch of Saluda River beginning at a pine and running thence N. 62 W. 33 chains to Black Oak; thence S 82 W. 15 chains to Spanish Oak on the Ridge; thence N. 8 chains 56 links to stake on Hagood Road; thence N. 55 E. 8 chains to Pine; thence N. 62 E. 49 chains to large pine; thence N. 65 E. 14.50 chains to Hickory on a branch; thence S. 16 E. 25 chains to White Oak at Blythe corner; thence S. 27 W. 17.50 chains to Hickory; thence S. 52 E. 16.50 chains to Poplar; thence S. 44 W. 16 chains to Post Oak; thence S. 75 W. 6 chains to Spruce; thence N. 62 W. 11 chains to Spanish Oak; thence N. 8 W. 13 chains to Spanish Oak; thence S. 85 W. 6.50 chains to the beginning corner, containing 240 acres more or less, said adjoining lands of James Hagood, W. B. Hardin, and less 17.4 acres conveyed by me to my father, W. B. Hardin, on the 10th day of December, 1913, said deed being recorded in Deed Book 250 page 111. This said tract of land containing 252.6 acres more or less, and being the same tract conveyed to me by J. L. Nolan, Mary A. Nolan, B. I. Rainer and W. B. Hardin, on the 6th day of November, 1913.
