(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
 Ambrose Williams and his heirs and assigns forever.
 All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate and
 being in Greenville County in Highland Township
 on South Tyger River containing 108 acres more or less
 which tract is made up of tract #3 and #4 on a plat
 of Bill D. News, C.E. of date Nov. 17th 1910 Recorded
 Jan. 8th 1916 in Vol. C. Page 266 and to which reference
 is hereby craved for a more particular description,
 being the same land deeded to J. H. Woodside and Jno.
 H. Kilreath by J. W. Gray Master for Greenville County
 and being same land deeded one half interest in
