(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said William N. Watson, his heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate at the South East corner of East North and Brown Streets, in the City and County of Greenville, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron post at the corner of said East North and Brown Streets and runs thence in a Southerly direction along Brown Street 150 ft. to the G. M. C. L. lot, thence in an Easterly direction along the line of that lot and parallel with East North Street 100 ft. to the Finlay property; thence in a Northerly direction along the line of the Finlay property and parallel with Brown Street 150 ft. to East North Street; thence in a Southerly direction along East North Street 100 ft. to the beginning corner being the lot of land deeded to me by P.
