KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Five Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by John T. Burgess

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said John T. Burgess, All that piece, parcel or tract of land containing 14-27/100 acres, more or less, situated in the Counties of Greenville and Spartanburg, State of South Carolina on the west side of the road leading from Pelham to Greer, and bounded by the following lines: Beginning at a stone in the west margin of said road, said stone being a corner of the lands of J.M. Davis and running thence along the west margin of the Road N. 30-10 E. 858 feet to the southwest boundary of the School-house tract; thence along said boundary of said tract N. 35-27 W. 185 feet and N. 3-07 W. 200 feet to an iron pipe in the boundary line of C.W. Davis lands; thence S. 79-27 W. 538 feet to a pipe, standing 10 feet east of the center line of a small water course; thence following the center line of said water course which runs approximately parallel to the following courses and distances S. 16-58 W. 232 feet, S. 17-49 E. 149 feet, S. 27-22 W. 386 feet, S. 9-35 E. 206 feet, S. 6-13 E. 119 feet; thence N. 85-40 E. 366 feet to beginning corner, bounded by lands The Pelham Mills, J.M. Davis, E.C. Greer, School-house and C.W. Davis.
