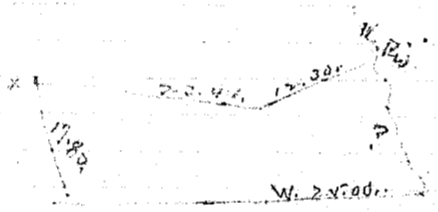

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mildred B. Watkins, her heirs and assigns, All of that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situated in the State and County aforesaid, about five miles from the City of Greenville, S.C. adjoining lands of Mrs. Beattie, and tracts Nos. 1 and 3 of the division of the real estate of the late Z.B. Watkins and shown on a survey and plat made by W.A. Adams, Nov. 26th, 1918 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on a stone on Mrs. Beatties line; thence S. 85-3/8 E. 23.44 to stone; thence N. 61-3/4 E. 12.30 to stake on Reedy River; thence down the meanders of said river to iron pin, corner of tracts No. 3; thence West 25.00 to iron pin; thence N. 29-1/2 W. 17.80 to the beginning, containing forty-six acres, more or less; this being tract No. 4 on the above named plat, also the Home Place.
