

W. P. Nesbitt DEED TO C. L. Patten

COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That W. P. Nesbitt of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Thirty hundred Dollars (\$3000.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by C. L. Patten

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

C. L. Patten and his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece, parcel, and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in Grove Township, containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, and having the following metes, courses and distances, to wit: Beginning at a point on Greenville Piedmont Road at corner of Piedmont Manufacturing Company's land, and running thence N. 32° E. 1.25 with said road to a stake 23; thence N. 74 1/4° E. 4.10 to a stake 23; thence S. 32° E. 1.25 to an iron stake 23 to land of Piedmont Manufacturing Company; thence S. 74° E. 4.10 to the beginning corner.

Also All that other piece, parcel or lot of land containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less, situate and being in Grove Township, in the State and County aforesaid, lying on West side of Greenville road, bounded on the South by the above described lot of land, on the West by lands of Piedmont Manufacturing Company, on the North by lands of S. J. Washmore, and on the East by Greenville road, and having the following metes, courses and distances, to wit: Beginning on Piedmont Manufacturing line; thence N. 32° E. 1.67 to iron stake 23; thence S. 62 1/4° E. 4.00 to center of Greenville road; thence S. 32° E. 83 links with the road to iron stake 23; thence N. 74 1/4° E. 4.10 to the beginning corner. The above lots being the same land conveyed to me by James O. Richly by deed bearing date December 27, 1915, and recorded in Vol. 35, page 126, R. M. C. Office Greenville County

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said C. L. Patten and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND myself do hereby bind

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said C. L. Patten and his heirs and assigns, against

myself and

my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
