(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. J. Morris and H. Frank Smith, their heirs and assigns, all my right and interest and easement as owner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5 of a Survey of J. N. Southern, July, 1897, of, in and to all that certain alley way or River Street, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, South Carolina, over eighteen foot strip on the western side of lot No. 3 of said survey, and being the same right of way reserved for the benefit of the owners of lot Nos. 4 & 5 of said survey, in the conveyance of W. C. Beattie, trustee, to J. W. Bell June 17, 1903, and recorded in the office of Register of Deeds' Conveyance for Greenville County in Book J. J. G. at page 701.
 Also all that piece, parcel or part of land situate, lying and being in Greenville City, Greenville County, South Carolina, on River Street, beginning at a stake on the northwest side of River Street on the southeast corner of lot No. 1, formerly belonging to Mary P. Bell and running thence N. 27 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. along River Street sixty-four feet to a stake in the southwest corner of lot No. 3, formerly belonging to J. W. Bell, thence line of last mentioned lot N. 62 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. one hundred and seventy feet to a stake on line of lot No. 5, thence S. 27 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. sixty-four feet along line of lot No. 4 & 5 to a stake on the northwest corner of lot No. 1, thence S. 62 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. One hundred and seventy feet to the beginning corner, and being one of the lots conveyed to me by Greenville Ice & Fuel Company Dec. 18, 1916; deed recorded in the office of Register of Deeds' Conveyance for Greenville County in Vol. 32 at page 481, reserving however, for the benefit of the owner or owners of lot Nos. 4 & 5 of Survey of J.
