DEED TO W. S. Smith

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. P. Ballenger of the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

Five Dollars and other valuable considerations

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by

W. S. Smith of Greenville, S. C.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. S. Smith, all that certain piece,

parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, outside the limits of the City of Greenville, S. C. and being known as lot no. 25 of the Suburban Land Company (known as Sans Souci Villa) plat of said property being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at page 510-11, said lot fronting on Brockman Avenue 91 feet, and being 84 feet on the back line, the north side line being 145 feet and the south side line being 169 feet.

Being the same lot conveyed to W. A. Chandler and J. P. Ballenger by A. L. Walker by his deed dated 22nd day of April, 1916, and W. A. Chandler's one-half undivided interest conveyed to me by his deed dated the 12th day of May, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 39 at page 339.

As a part of the consideration of this deed of conveyance, it is understood and agreed that the said W. S. Smith is to assume and a mortgage of Three Hundred Dollars given by J. P. Ballenger to W. S. Wood, May 13th, 1916, said mortgage recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 53 at page 121. Interest on said mortgage being paid to Nov. 13th, 1917.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said

W. S. Smith, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind

myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said

W. S. Smith, his

heirs and assigns, against

heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
