KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, H. Alex Griffith, B.T. Griffith, Elizabeth R. Taylor, Mary Ann Griffith, Frances Bannister, C. Oregon Sullivan, and I. Keziah Jenkins, of the County

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fourteen hundred seventy (\$1470) DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W.J. Alexander

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W.J. Alexander, All our right, title and interest as heirs of Matthew A. Griffith,

deceased, in and to that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing twenty-eight (28) acres, more or less, and having the following lines, courses and distances, according to a survey and plat made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor, on March 29, 1917, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on road leading to the City of Greenville, corner of W.J. Alexander thence with said road N. 11-1/2 E. 9.73 to bend in road, corner of cemetery; thence continuing with said road N. 16 W. 3.19 to iron pin on road; thence with line of Rebecca Clarke S. 84 W. 12.34 to iron pin; thence continuing with line of Rebecca Clarke N. 68-1/4 W. 10.70 to iron pin, corner Mrs. Ida Charles; thence S. 25-1/4 W. 12.44 to iron pin; thence along line of W.J. Alexander S. 81 E. 26.75 chains to the beginning. Our interest in the lands hereinbefore described being as heirs of Matthew A. Griffith, deceased, who died intestate, leaving as his heirs his brothers and sisters, being the grantors herein, and the children of a deceased brother, William Griffith, to-wit: James T. Griffith, Lee Griffith, B.M. Griffith, John M. Griffith and Hattie Reece.
