(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
unto the said Carle L. Hart his heirs and assigns forever.

A tract or parcel of land being and being situated in
the State and County aforesaid, containing 5 1/2 hundred
acres (600) more or less, more particularly described in a
deed from M. L. Hart to Matilda Hart dated Jan 26
1888, recorded in deed book 27 Page 125 R. M. C. O., said
County, as follows: On north side of Oil Camp Creek waters of
middle Santee River, beginning on a perpendicular north of
Oil Camp Creek a corner of W. M. Jones land runs thence
