KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Mrs. John B. Marshall, and W. E. Beattie, as Executors and Trustees under and by virtue of the power contained in the last will and testament of Mrs. Ann E. Marshall, and the said John B. Marshall, in the State aforesaid, in his own right,

in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Hundred (\$1800.00) DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. P. Poole

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. P. Poole

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in said County and State, on the South West side of Pinckney Street, between Mulberry and Frank Streets, known and designated as lot No. 6 on a plat made by Will S. Nevel, dated February 4th 1912, showing 3 lots situate on Pinckney Street, and 3 lots situate on Hampton Avenue, and having according to such plat, the following metes, and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on Pinckney Street 128 feet and 4 inches from the Pinckney Street public school lot belonging to the City of Greenville, and running thence along said Pinckney Street E. 34 E. 64 feet and 2 inches to corner of lot belonging to William H. Irvine or Henry Madler, thence along line of said lot S. 57. 30 W. 199 feet to a stake on corner of lot No. 1; thence N. 33. 15 W. 64 feet and 5 inches along line of lot No. 1 to stake on the common corner of lots 1, 2, 5, & 6; thence N. 57. 40 E. 198 feet along line of lot No. 5 to the beginning corner; this being the portion of lot No. 26 of the W. G. McBee Farm, conveyed to Ann E. Marshall by J. L. Southern, Sheriff, by deed bearing date the 3rd day of January, 1876, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book volume "H H" page 425. See instrument of writing recorded in Volume 22, page 252.
