to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by G. H. Medlin

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said G. H. Medlin

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in the County of Greenville, and having the following meters and bounds: Beginning at a point on Cox Street, corner of lot no. 21 and thence thence along the line of lot No. 21 and 22, 138.2 feet; thence N. 76-15 E. 60 feet to corner of lot No. 19; thence along this line, 136.8 feet to Cox street; thence along said Cox Street 60 feet to the beginning corner, being known as lot No. 20 on a plat of land called "Willcrest" surveyed by Will D. News.

Also all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate as aforesaid, having the following meters and bounds: Beginning at a point on the corner of South and Cox Streets, and thence with South Street 42.8 feet to corner of lot no. 22; thence along the line of lot No. 22, 114 feet to line of lot No. 20 thence along line of lot No. 20, 69.1 feet, to Cox Street; thence along said Cox Street 135.5 feet to the beginning corner, being lot No. 21 on above described plat of land.
