(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
 unto the said Wm. G. Sirrine

All that certain lot of land situate in the
 second ward of the City of Greenville, County of
 Greenville and State of South Carolina, off of
 the North side of East Stone Avenue, and more
 particularly described as follows;

Begins at an iron pin on the North
 side of East Stone Avenue at a point fifty four
 and one-half (54 1/2) feet West of Bennett St.
 and running thence N. 17° E. two hundred and
 six and one-half (206 1/2) feet to an iron pin;
 thence N. 73° W. fifty four and one-half (54 1/2)
 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17° W. two hundred
 and six and one-half (206 1/2) feet to an iron
 pin on Stone Avenue, thence with Stone Ave.
 S. 73° E. fifty four and one-half (54 1/2) feet to the
 beginning.
