(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said G. W. Kelly

All that piece, parcel and lot of land, situate in the State and County aforesaid, on Pendleton Road, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at iron pin on Pendleton Road and running thence S. 44-30 W. 109.3' to pin; thence S. 47-0 E. 50' to stake; thence N. 44-30 E. 130.4' to iron pin on Pendleton Road; thence along Pendleton Road N. 69-48 W. 54.9' to the beginning corner. All of which will more fully appear by plat (revised) made by P. E. Daxton, Eng'r. August 1918. That said plat his house situate thereon. It is agreed that G. W. Kelly shall forever have access or a way out to a back alley, free and unobstructed at all times.
