KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Mrs. Sue Robbins of Greenville County in the State aforesaid

in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of five dollars DOLLARS,  
to me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by my brother James H. Glenn, and the love and affection which I have for my said Brother and his children

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said James H. Glenn

All that piece, parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville Township in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Mrs. Ella Babb, W. H. Irvine, and Thos. G. Glenn containing ten acres more or less, being the tract of land and premises, whereon I now live, situated on the South side of the Greenville and Laurens Road, and about one and one half miles from the City of Greenville to have and to hold the same for and during the period of his natural life, and at his death to go to his surviving children, and if at his death any of his said children be dead, leaving children, then such child or children to receive the share which the parent would have received if living, with the proviso, however, that there shall be no division of the said property until the youngest child of the said James H. Glenn shall arrive at the age of twenty one years, but the same shall be kept together for a home of said children, if they choose to live there, until that time.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said James H. Glenn and his children as above provided, and their heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said James H. Glenn and his said children as herein above provided, and their heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
