

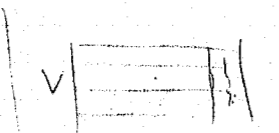

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. J. Blasingame of the
County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid,
in consideration of the sum of
Two Dollars and other good and valuable considerations
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by L. H. Hunt

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
unto the said L. H. Hunt

All that certain piece parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being on Ordeal Street in Block
5 of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville
and State of South Carolina, and having the
following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning
at an Iron Pin on Ordeal Street, corner of
Spatt, Shop, and running thence N. 70.30 E. 76.6
feet to an Iron pin on slight foot alley; thence
with said Alley N. 19.30 W. 43 feet to an iron
Pin, corner of lot this day conveyed to J. H.
Bridges; thence with his line S. 70.39 W. 76.6
feet to an Iron pin on Ordeal Street; thence
with Ordeal Street S 19.30 E. 43 feet to the beginning
corner.

It is understood and agreed that the
alley hereinabove referred to, in the rear of
this property, the same being eight feet in
width, is to forever remain open for the
use of the grantee, his heirs and assigns
and of the grantor his heirs and assigns.
The grantor is to pay all the taxes that
are now due, including the year 1918, and
possession is to be given on the 1st day of
January, 1919.
