All that certain parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in said State said County and adjoining land of Thos Burton Earle Coffey, Joe Hofford, Isaac & Hofford and others, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning out of fence Joe Hofford's corner and running with his line S. 18° 21' 12" E. 70 chs to a red oak; thence N. 50° 4' E. 30.50 chs to pine knot near a white oak, Harton's corner on the line; thence N. 68° E. 16.00 chs. to a white oak on Earle line; thence with the Earle line S. 10° E. 15.50 chs to a stake; thence S. 35° E. 4 chains to a red oak; thence S. 70° E. 18.50 chs. to the beginning corner, and containing fifty two (52) acres more or less, and being the said tract conveyed to me by T.P.
