the City of Greenville and having the following  
metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron  
pin 37 N.M. White horse road S. M. Cox's line, and

L. S. Bagnmonds' line, now L. C. Childress' thence  
S 44 W. 30 links to an iron pin on L. S. Thurstans
