C. and on the Little Texas road adjoining lands of Mrs. Mary Hill, Mrs. Tropic R. Evans and others, containing Twenty and Fifty Nine one hundredths (20.69/100) acres more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit; Beginning at a stone on the Little Texas road and running thence N.  $\frac{1}{8}$  E. 11.00 to a stone 3x0m thence N. 68.34 W. 8.00 to a stone; Thence S. 25 W. 3.36 to stone. Thence S. 2 E. 3.36 to a stone N. M. Thence S. 33 W. 5.00 to a stone N. M. Thence N. 63.44 W. 2.79 to a stone, O. M.
