unto the said L. B. Lockhart

All that certain lot or piece parcel of land

Mountain Township on both sides of Jamison's
Mill creek, Big running at a large white O. 3x old
running thence S. 44 1/2 E. 7 1/2 Ch. to a stone, thence
N. 35 3/4 E. 32.14 Ch. to stone in place of Hickory now
gone, thence S. 83 1/2 W. 14.30 to a pine stump, thence
S. 34 W. 19.80 Ch. to a stone, thence S. 24 1/2 E. 2.76 Ch.

heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

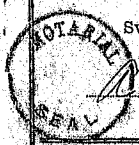
