 Thomas Smith by a narrow strip about 121  
 feet wide, left for a wagon road and from  
 H. C. Goldightly's by the public road leading  
 from Batesville to Greenville containing eight  
 and three quarters acres, be the same, greater  
 or less, having the following described marsh
