(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said T. E. Malone, James H. Price, Walter Goldsmith and

John Abernathy All those pieces parcels or lots of land situate lying and being in Chick Spring Township Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a portion of the E. M. Wharton sub division out near Paris Station in said County and State and has the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at stake on the National Highway cornered lots numbers 75 and 76, running thence along said Highway N. 60-16 E. seventy five feet to a stake cornered lots 78 and 79, thence in line of lots 78 and 79 N. 29-44 W. fifty feet to corner lots 78 and 79 and in line of lot number 75, thence S. 60-16 W. along the back line of lots 78-77 and 76 seventy five feet to a stake cornered lots 76 and 75, thence running in line of lots 75 and 76 S. 29-44 E. fifty feet to the beginning corner.
