 unto the said Annie Mai Fuller All of my right, title

and interest, the same being an undivided and  
 fourth interest in and to the following de-  
 scribed tracts of land:  
 All that certain tract situate in the County and  
 State aforesaid, on the head waters of Andrew River  
 and having the following metes and bounds  
 to wit: Beginning at a stone 3 1/4 Crains corner, thence
