and interest, the same being an undivided one-fourth interest in and to the following described tracts of land:
 All that certain tract situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the head waters of Embury River and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone 3 1/4 Crains corner, thence S. 33 N. 13. 96 chs to a stone, thence N. 72 N. 17. 58 chs to a stone 3 1/4 on Huffer line; thence N. 18 3/4 E. 6. 89 chs to a stone; thence S. 89 E. 22 chs to the beginning corner and containing Seventeen (17) acres, more or less.
