 to me in hand paid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Sallie V. Miller all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, and with in the corporate limits of Greer, containing one and three eighths acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances: Beginning at a stake on the mosteller Road and running S. 56 1/2 E. 200 feet; thence S. 25 W. 177 feet; thence with the railroad S. 72 W. 240 feet to the said mosteller Road; thence with said mosteller Road to the beginning corner, bounded by the mosteller Road, the Southern Railway and lands of Mrs. Barrie Ballenger, and being the same lot of land conveyed to Rachael E. Tucker by Sebray Duncan by deed dated 16th Nov. 1880 and recorded in the office of the R. M.
