(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Charles McAlister, all of our interest or claims to the following described piece of property, all that certain piece of land and lot of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, Beginning at a stake on the Gilbert Shoals road and running thence N. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 17.50 to an oak stake, thence N. 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 40.80 to a stone, thence N. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 18.10 to a post oak, thence S. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 26.50 to a stone, thence N. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 16.75 to a Poplar, thence S. 21 E. 20.80 to a silver gum, thence S. 63 W. 2.50 to a stone, thence S. 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 18.35 to a stake on the Gilbert Shoals road, thence with said road S. 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.95 to the beginning corner, containing eighty-four (84) acres more or less.
