KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, J. W. Sullivan, A. C. Sullivan,
J. T. Sullivan, Ellen Strander and Fannie Sullivan

In the State aforesaid,

Ten Dollars and other valuable Consideration DOLLARS,
to us
in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by J. E. Knight, Jr.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release
unto the said J. E. Knight, Jr.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate,
lying and being in Franklin Township, County
of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having
the following corner and bounds: Beginning
at a Spring on a stone, thence S. 72° N. 23.63 to
a stone; thence S. 79° E. 27.75 to a stone at the
branch, thence along the branch N. 25.72 N. 71.80
to a stake; thence N. 32° N. 2.85 to a stake,
thence N. 38° N. 10.25 to a stake, thence N. 56° E.
2.55 to a stake; thence N. 53° 4' N. 9.40 to a stake
thence N. 59 1/2° N. 4.00 to a stake; thence N. 65° N.
2.50 to the beginning corner containing 39
and thirteen one hundred acres, more or
less and being the same land conveyed
to John I. Sullivan by B. M. McIse on the
fifth day of November 1905 by deed recorded in
office of the Register of Deeds Convenanted
for Greenville County, S.C. in Vol. R.M.R. page 232
Also all that other parcel or tract of land

heirs and assigns, against

heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
