 at and before the sealing of these presents by Lee McMakin.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lee McMakin, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in Highland Township, and having the following written and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone 34.0 m. near a large double poplar tree and running N. 72^{3/4} W. 5.76 chs. to a stone, 34.0 m. on branch, (near a large rock); thence with the meanderings of said branch to South Tiger river; thence down the meanderings of the said river to a stone 34.0 m. at the old run of the river; thence up the old run 3.00 to a stone 34. old mark; whence N. 1 W. 5.67 chs. to a sweet gum tree 34. N. 7m. whence N. 64 and 34 E. 17.50 chs. to a small sweet gum bush, 34. N. 7m. whence N. 46 and 38. E. 8.50 chs. to a sweet gum tree on branch 34. N. 7m. whence N. 66 E. 1.00 to a white oak and stone (stone gone); whence N. 59 E. 13.63 chs. to a stone; whence N. 25 W. 19.70 chs. to a stone; whence N. 43 1/4 W. 4.75 chs. to a stone; whence S. 61 N. 3.70 chs. to a sweet gum tree on quarry; thence down the meanderings of the said quarry and branch is a south-westerly direction to a stone on the branch; whence S. 17.50 N. 10. chs. to the beginning corner and containing One hundred Acres, more or less, this being a part of the old plantation (now) place and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Marvin R. Reece by deed dated the 25th day of September 1913, which land is bounded by boundaries of John Parrot, D. G. Reece, Hartwell Beackson, C. Wilson, T. C. and others. This conveyance is made with the distinct understanding and agreement on the part of the said Lee McMakin that he assumes the payment of a certain sum and mortgage over the above described land in the sum of Three Thousand and ~~no~~ ²⁰ (83,000.00) Dollars held by the Bank of Greenville dated the 21st day of November 1913, and the assumption of the same shall not affect the title heretofore made in favor of the said Marvin R. Reece for that conveyance.
