DEED TO L. A. Waldrop

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John T. Curton, as Executor of the last will and testament of David B. T. Curton, of Greenville County,

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said L. A. Waldrop, her heirs and assigns forever:

all those two certain pieces, parcels and tracts of land situate in Greenville County, South Carolina described as follows, to wit:- also that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid out waters of Reedy Fork of Reedy River containing fifty acres more or less, beginning at Waldrop's corner on Georgia road, thence S. 4° E. 41.46 chs to stake in Nesbitt & Ironbridge line, thence S. 78 4/5 E. 12.75 chs to stake, thence N. 6 1/2 W. 45.75 chs to stake near branch on said road; thence along said road S. 79 1/2 W. 10.68 chs to the beginning corner and bounded by lands of Waldrop, Nesbitt & Ironbridge, said polygon and others more particularly known by survey and plat of same made by H. P. Robinson, said tract of land being conveyed to D. B. T. Curton by Robert B. Lyon by deed bearing date Feb 14th 1882, Recorded in Vol N.W. page 197.

Also a certain tract or parcel of lands containing sixteen acres, more or less, the same being in said State and County above mentioned on Baker's Creek and adjoining lands of L. A. Waldrop, T. B. Watson and others, and bounded east by Baker's Creek and west by lands of the said D. B. T. Curton this being the land mentioned in bond for title by R. B. Lyon Book of Record 22nd Dec 1885, page 43 and conveyed to D. B. T. Curton by L. A. Waldrop by deed bearing date Nov 10th, 1891 and recorded in R. M. C. Office of Greenville County in Vol 47 page 55.

The above two tracts of land were sold at public auction before the Court House in Greenville S.C. on Saturday in December 1917 (Dec. 3rd 1917) under the terms of the last Will and Testament of D. B. T. Curton, Said will being of record in Probate Judge's office for said County in Book "M" of Wills, pages 176-178, L. A. Waldrop being the highest bidder at said sale.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said
