KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Ella J. Sheppard of Greenville County

In the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of Three thousand (\$3000.00) DOLLARS,
 to J. D. Sheppard in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by J. D. Sheppard

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. D. Sheppard his heirs and assigns, All the following described real-estate, to-wit:

First.
 All that certa in piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and City and County of Greenville, in Ward #2 of said City, on Richland Creek, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a steke on un-named Street and running thence S. 69 E. 133 feet to a stake, corner of said un-named Street and North Street, corner of Ella J. Sheppards lot; thence N. 13 W. 61 feet to a stake on south bank of Richland creek; thence along said creek bank as a line 95 feet to a stake on bank of Creek; thence in a straight line 20 feet to the beginning corner, and known as lot #4 on plat of lands of Martha J. Howell- said plat recorded in Plat Book "C", at page 154 and 155; this being the same land conveyed to me by J.W. Gray, Master for Greenville County by deed dated 7th, day of April 1914, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Vol. #14 of Deeds, at page 200.

Second.
 All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and City and County of Greenville, in Ward #2 of said City, at the foot of North Street, and fully described in deed from M.P. Hall to A.C. Davis, dated Oct. 24th, 1894, recorded in Deed Book "BBB", at page 289 in said R.M.C. Office; this being the same lot of land conveyed to me, the said Ella J. Sheppard by A.C. Davis by deed dated 24th, day of June, 1915 and recorded in R.M.C. Office for said County and State in Volume #27 of Deeds, at page 529.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said J. D. Sheppard, and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. D. Sheppard, and his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
