(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said L. E. Chamberlain: All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate and lying in the County and State aforesaid bounded by the land of T. P. Cottman, D. D. Higginson, H. C. Fowler and others, containing 106 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres, more or less, being the estate of C. G. Thackson, deceased, who having died intestate, his heirs, all being of legal age, are herein making title thereto. Said piece of property beginning at a stone and running thence S. 37 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 15.50 to a poplar stump, thence S. 53 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 26.18 to a stone on public road, thence along road N. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 9.60 to stone, thence S. 36 E. 4.04 to stone, thence N. 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 26.83 to stone on branch, thence up said branch, the branch being the line except where noted in a plat of said property on record in the office of A.
