Two thousand thirty (\$2030.00) Dollars,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release
unto the said Gertrude Harrison the following

real estate, to-wit:-

"all that certain piece, parcel and tract
of land being and lying in Greenville County
and State of South Carolina, about five
miles from Greenville Court House on the
Augusta Road and running thence n. 55 w.
6.40 to a small P.O.; thence S. 73 1/2 W. 17.00 to a
stake; thence S. 35 E. 16.00 to a stake in road; thence
with said road as a line 19.80 to the beginning
corner and containing twenty acres, more or
less, and being the same tract of land convey-
ed to Bud Ward by J. M. D. Ashmore, January

508"

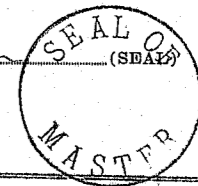
TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident
