same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.

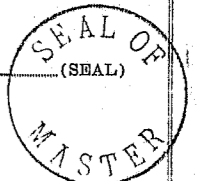
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises beforementioned, unto the said
