WHEREAS, Mary J. Garrison

on or about the 9th, day of October in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and seventeen exhibited her complaint in the Court of  
Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Florence C. Adams, Lou K. Bramlett, Margaret M. Ellison,  
William C. Garrison, Rosa K. Ashmore, J. Walter Moon, Lizzie Ashmore, Mary M. Chiles,  
J.A. Moon, Grace Pepper, Francis Pepper, William Pepper and Lula Grace Campbell,

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter  
mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 7th,  
day of January 1918, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a  
decree of the said Court,

being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I E. Inman  
Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of  
Three thousand - - - Dollars,  
to me paid by the said W.H. Willimon

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said W.H. Willimon, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate,

lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being known  
and designated as lot No. 3, according to a survey and plat of the Joel B. Garrison lands  
made by W.J. Riddle, surveyor on February 7th, and 8th, 1918 and having, according to said  
plat, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:  
Beginning at a stone, the southeast corner of tract No. 2, and running thence North  
14-20 East 38.74 to a stone; thence North 18 West 4.20 to a stake; thence South 78-10  
West 3.50 to a maple; thence South 26-45 West 13.85 to a stone; thence South 44-50 West 22.25 to a  
stone; thence South 53 East 21.20 to the beginning corner, and containing forty-four and  
41/100 (44.41) acres, and adjoins tract No.2
