unto the said B. M. M^e Gee the following described real estate

Carolina, containing sixty two acres, more or less and
bounded by lands of Paris Mountain Water Company
J. R. Alcorn, et al and being the same tract
conveyed to Katie Storey by J. W. Dickson on March
4, 1915

same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.

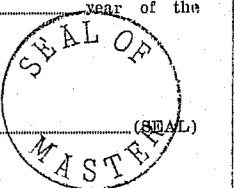
