WHEREAS, Jennie McDaniel, Plaintiff

on or about the 17th day of December in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and eighteen exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against J. O. Allen, Individually and as

Administrator, Eliza A. Allen, Mary J. Sloan, Fannie S. Robinson, Abbie Walker, and J. C. Coughlin, Defendants

demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th day of March 1919, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a verdict of the said Court,

whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described be sold by E. Inman Master in and for the County aforesaid, of the terms and for the purposes mentioned in the said decree as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; and the Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate

for sale by public outcry on the 7th day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and nineteen did then openly and publicly, according to the custom of auction, sell and dispose of the same unto J. O. Allen

for the sum of Twelve Hundred Seventy (\$1270.00) Dollars, being at that price the highest bidder therefor.

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I E. Inman Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twelve Hundred Seventy (\$1270.00) Dollars, to me paid by the said J. O. Allen

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. O. Allen the following real estate, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, in said # 62 on Thompson Street, and being a portion of the land owned by Samuel B. McDaniel at the time of his death, and being known and designated as lot No. 1 according to a revised survey and plat thereof made by R. E. Hutton Esq., April 7, 1919 and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a wall on the south side of Thompson Street, 119 feet from the southeast corner of the intersection of Thompson and Ann Streets and running thence N. 78. 36 E. 142 feet to a wall on the corner of lot No. 3, on said plat; thence N. 10. 21 W. 54 feet to a wall on the south side of Thompson Street; thence along line of said Thompson Street S. 43. 4 E. 54 feet to the beginning corner.

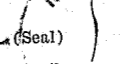
