the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release
unto the said

Mary L. Pack and her heirs and assigns forever, the
following described real estate;
"All that tract, parcel and lot of land lying and
being in Bates Township, County and State aforesaid,
containing ninety-six acres, more or less, bounded on
the East by lands of Berry Kiddle, on the south by
lands of John Rosemond, on the west by lands of
Mack Farr and on the north by the estate of J. M.
Whitnire, and being the same tract of land conveyed
to Mary L. Pack by W. P. Henderson and conveyed by
Mary L. Pack to Flora F. Jennings."

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident
or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the
